












THIS INDENTURE WITNESSETH AS FOLLOWS:

1. That, the **SETTLER** is the absolute owner of a sum of Rs. 1,51,000/- (Rs. One Lakh fifty one Thousand only) and here by conveys, transfer and grants in to the hands of the **TRUSTEES** named herein above to hold the same for the said Trust to carry out the objects and purposes and for wishes of the **SETTLER** according to the direction herein below.
2. That the name of the trust shall be "**SKY VISION PUBLIC SERVICE TRUST**".
3. **OFFICE OF THE TRUST:**
That the office of the trust shall be situated at:

4. **THE TRUSTEES** shall be as liberty to transfer the office or may open branch or branches at any place and / or places within the territories of India at their mutual consent / decision from time to time.
5. That the first trustees are empowered to appoint **Mrs. Sabita Sharma** as managing trustee who shall be the convener and chairman of the said trust.

6. **That the objects for which this trust is established are:**

(a) To establish, develop, maintain and grant aid in cash or in kind to School, hospitals, Medical College, Engineering College, B.Ed. College, Industrial Training Institute, College, A.N.M Training School, Dental College and other professional, technical and vocational institution, dispensaries, maternity homes, child welfare centers and /or such other similar charitable institutions in India for the benefit and use of the child and general public in the state of Bihar as well as in any other place or places in India.

(b) To establish, maintain or grant aid to homes for the aged, orphanages or other establishments for the relief and help to the poor, needy and destitute people, orphans, widows and aged persons.

(c) To lay the foundation of incomparable, invaluable and precious treasury of ingenuity with annotated description of various innovative topic and inspire with impetus towards development of the lower strata of the people.

- (d) To set motion and play a proactive role in giving direction, for a quiet social global movement and revolution for socio-economic educational, cultural, scientific, technical, financial, ethical, integral prosperity and take spearheaded initiatives to spread the gain of prosperity, in the benefit of throughout masses of world of living creature.
- (e) To undertake, encourage, carryout, activate, assist, participate or organize all programmes of integrated remote rural development including small and rural technologies promotion and development, micro enterprises development, watershed and waste land/other unutilized resource management.
- (f) To activate, carryout, undertake, assist organize or manage all programmes of health and family welfare including reproductive maternal and child health programme, gender issues, highly sensitive disease care and cure, intensive immunization, family planning and population information, education, research, communication and training.
- (g) To undertake encourage or develop alternative system of medicine i.e., Indian medicine, Homeopathy, Polypathy, Yunani ayurvedic, yoga, acupressure, acupuncture, etc. and promote intensive and extensive education of the public to motivate them to donate blood, eyes, and other limbs. - (r) To undertake, develop, manage, arrange or organize antique show, art show, audio and video show, fashion show, magic show, thematic puppet show, charity premier show, car rally, dance events, fancy dress competition, fete greeting card and handicraft exhibition film shows foundation or endowment of award and prizes.
- (s) To develop, promote, manage, undertake or arrange tours and picnics, health club, toy libraries, yoga classes, judo classes, tourism and tourism engineering promotion, cultural development, archaeological and archive, khadi handicraft and cottage industries promotion, game matches, printing calendar, book writing, publication, news paper, scholarship, promote small savings, placement assistance and security alert, employment creation and opportunities development programme.

- (v) The Trust will not carry out any activities with the intention of earning profit and will perform with service motive only.
7. That the Trust Fund may be augmented by the income from the initial fund and also by donations and other contribution from time to time
8. That the Trust Fund shall not be applied for any purpose other than those specified in Para 6 herein above unless the other objects added to the trust objectives.
9. That the Trustees shall always maintain proper accounts of the Trust, which shall be kept at the office of the trust.
10. The day to day works and substantial powers of Board of trustee with be vested to Mrs. Sabita Sharma and she shall be designated as "Managing Trustee (Chair person)."

11. Subject to the Provisions of Income Tax Act. 1961 as amended from time to time, the Trustees will keep the Trust fund or such portion thereof, as they may, in their absolute discretion, think fit and proper, in legal way answerable or accountable to the beneficiaries or any other party for any loss invested in such shares, stock, securities and debentures of acquisition or construction of any immovable property including buildings and/or in the purchase and acquisition or mortgage by way of fresh charge on any immovable property in India, of free-hold or lease-hold tenure, and may deposit the amounts with any scheduled Bank, Company or Private firm or Individual on such terms and conditions as they think fit, In the matter of investment of Trust funds, the provisions of section 20 of the Indian Trust Act shall apply; in the event of Trustees purchasing any immovable property or properties or advancing moneys or mortgage, they shall be entitled to accept such title or evidence of title as they shall think fit in their absolute and uncontrolled discretion. The Trustees shall have power, if any deed it in their absolute discretion to sell the Trust Fund or any part thereof and any such immovable property purchased by them under the power aforesaid and any other shares, securities, etc. and stand possessed of the money to arise from such sale upon after paying there out the expenses pertaining to such sale upon the Trusts and with the subject to powers and provision including all the posers contained by and under these presents declared and contained concerning the Trust Fund which or the proceeds thereof, shall have laid out in purchase of property or properties as have laid out in purchase of property or properties as aforesaid or such of them as shall be then subsisting and capable of taking effect.

12. The Trustees shall be accountable only for such moneys, and funds which will actually come into their hands.
13. The Trustees will not be entitled to receive any remuneration, but the Trustee may reimburse themselves all expenses actually incurred by them in connection with the Trust or their duties relating thereto.

14. **MANAGING TRUSTEE:**

Mrs. Sabita Sharma shall be Managing trustee for time being of this Trust, who shall subject to the control and supervision of the TRUSTEES look after the day-to-day affairs and administration of this Trust. On resignation or death of the aforesaid, TRUSTEES may nominate / elect a Managing Trustee from amongst them, and fix the period and terms of office.

TRUSTEES:

15. a) The number of TRUSTEES shall not be less than two and more than eleven. If the number of TRUSTEES falls below two the remaining

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TRUSTEES shall not act on behalf of the Trust except for the purpose of filling up a vacancy, as long as the number of TRUSTEES is below the minimum.


- b) The TRUSTEES for the time being will be at liberty to appoint additional TRUSTEE(S) within the number mentioned above, for such period or on such terms as to retirement and re-appointment as the TRUSTEES for the time being may consider proper. If any TRUSTEE dies, retires, becomes unfit or incapable to act, the continuing or surviving TRUSTEES or TRUSTEE may appoint a TRUSTEE in place of the incapacitate TRUSTEE.
- c) Except for the initial TRUSTEES, who shall cease to be a TRUSTEE only on death or through voluntary resignation, a TRUSTEE shall cease to hold office if he or she :
- i) Leaves without absence ;
 - ii) Does not attend three consecutive meetings of the Trust or fails to attend meetings for one calendar year, whichever is longer; or
 - iii) Is requested to resign by 2/3rd of the TRUSTEES or as near to this number as possible of the remaining TRUSTEES.
- d) Any TRUSTEE is at liberty to resign from the Trust on giving one month prior notice in writing of his/her intention to do so.
- e) The TRUSTEE is at liberty to resign from the trust on giving one month's prior notice in writing of his or her intention to do so.

16. POWER OF THE TRUSTEES

- a) The TRUSTEES shall be at liberty, at their absolute discretion to accept any property, contributions, grants, collection or donations from persons, firms, companies or government or other institutions, including foreign agencies / institutions or foreign governments, for the advancements of the objects of the Trust.
- b) The TRUSTEES shall be entitled from time to time to open and maintain Banks accounts in the name of Trust with a bank or banks, to operate such account(s) and to give instructions to the bank(s) and to provide for may create a corpus jointly by the two or more TRUSTEES or Agents appointed by the TRUSTEES.
- c) The TRUSTEES may borrow or raise moneys or funds from banks, financial institutions, government, other institutions, persons, firms and companies for the purpose and the objects of the Trust on such terms and conditions as they may think fit in the interest of the Trust and mortgage, pledge or otherwise secure all or any of the properties or investments of the Trust as a security against such borrowings.

- d) The TRUSTEES shall be at liberty to sell and / or realize the Trust property, if and when acquire, in future or funds and invest the sale proceeds thereof or any other moneys, being part of the Trust Fund, in any manner as the TRUSTEES may time to time think fit, within the scope of this Trust and within the scope of law.
- e) The TRUSTEES may lend money either with or without security.
- f) The TRUSTEES may set apart any part of the income of the Trust in accordance with provisions of the law including the income tax-law applicable for the time being.
- g) The TRUSTEES may create a corpus Fund out of any specific grant or donation or out of the income of the trust and invest the same in suitable long term investments and may out of the corpus of the Trust spend such money or out of the sale proceeds or any part thereof appropriate such money or part thereof for all or any of the charitable objects, and purposes of the Trust.
- h) The Managing Trustees or the TRUSTEES may appoint regular, permanent, part-time or honorary staff, if necessary and according to the requirement for managing or working of the Trust and use the Trust funds for payment of their salaries, compensation, expenses, etc.
- i) The TRUSTEES may construct, school, laboratories, buildings, dispensaries, clinics, operating theaters, hospitals, orphan home, eye-banks and or purchase or take on lease of any of all of them and such other equipment, instruments, apparatus, machinery, and/or vehicles as may be necessary for carrying out the objects and purposes of the Trust.
- j) The TRUSTEES MAY let or hire out any movable or immovable properties belonging to the Trust for such period and at such rent or charge and on such terms and conditions as the TRUSTEES in their discretion may think fit in the interest of the Trust.
- k) The TRUSTEES may subject to the provisions of law, contribute to the funds of any professional association, individual, firm, corporate body society, organization or institution, which in the opinion of the TRUSTEES is beneficial to the Trust.
- l) The TRUSTEES may join, co-operate or amalgamate this Trust with other.
- m) The TRUSTEES may institute, defend, adjust, settle, compromise, compound, refer to arbitration, all actions, suits, claims, demands and proceedings regarding the Trust property or the the Trust funds.
- n) The TRUSTEES may appoint constituted attorney(s) or agent(s) and to delegate to such attorney(s) or agent(s) all or any of the power vested in them under this Trust Deed and from time to time remove such attorney(s) or agent(s) and to appoint other or others in his or their place(s).

- o) The TRUSTEES have power to frame rules and regulations to carry out and to give effect to the objects and the purposes of the Trust and/or managing the affairs of the Trust and to alter, and or amend the same time to time.
- p) The TRUSTEES may do any other thing or things which is/are incidental and conducive to the attainment of the aims and objects or any one of them.

MEETING:

- 17 a) The managing trustee for the time being shall be authorized to call a meeting of the TRUSTEES by giving notice in writing or oral to the other TRUSTEES.
- b) Managing TRUSTEE along with two of the TRUSTEES shall form a quorum for a meeting of the TRUSTEES.
- c) All matters will be decided unanimously by the Managing Trustee and the majority of the TRUSTEES at a meeting convened for that purpose.
- d) Resolutions may be passed without holding a meeting of the TRUSTEES by circulating in writing the proposed resolutions, which must be endorsed by the Managing Trustee and two thirds of the TRUSTEES. If resolutions are endorsed in this manner, they shall be as valid and effectual as resolutions passed at a meeting of the TRUSTEES.
- e) The TRUSTEES shall keep or cause to be kept a minute book of the proceedings of the meetings.
- f) The TRUSTEES may, if so decided unanimously, dissolve the Trust and transfer the trust and / or such part of portion thereof as shall, for the time being remain in the hands of the TRUSTEES, or the investment and properties of the Trust or a part thereof to any other institutions or trust for pursuing the objects specified, but no part of the Trust funds, assets or liabilities shall be transferred to the SETTLER or any of the TRUSTEES at any time or under any circumstances, upon dissolution.

FINANCE & ACCOUNTS

- 19) a) It shall be lawful for the TRUSTEES to settle all accounts and to compromise, compound, abandon or refer to arbitration any action or proceedings or dispute, claim, demand or things, proper for such purpose without being responsible for any loss occasioned thereby.

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b) It shall be lawful for the TRUSTEES to apply for the government, public bodies, urban, local, municipal, district and other bodies, corporations, companies, or persons for and to accept grants of money, aid, donations, gifts, subscriptions and other assistance with a view to promoting the aims and other assistance with a view to promoting the aims and objects of the Trust and to discuss and negotiate with the government departments, public and other bodies, corporations, companies or persons, schemes and other works and matters within the aims proper condition upon which such grants and other payments may be made.

c) The TRUSTEES shall cause true and accurate accounts to be kept of all moneys received and spent and of all matters in respect thereof in the course of the management of the Trust property or in relation to the carrying out of the aims and objects of the Trust as well as of all assets, credits and effects of the Trust property.

d) The accounting year of the Trust shall be the financial year ending on 31ST March every year.

l) Books of account shall be audited by a chartered accountant every financial year.

20. It is expressly declared that no part of the Trust property or its income or any accretion thereto shall be applied for any purpose outside India or for any purpose which is not a charitable purpose in law, and all provisions hereof shall be construed according.

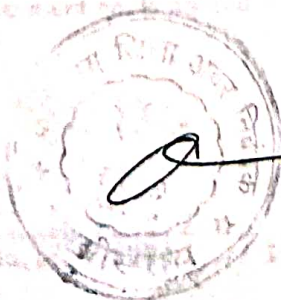
21 a) The Trust shall be authorized to function throughout India.
